—Psalm 119:105

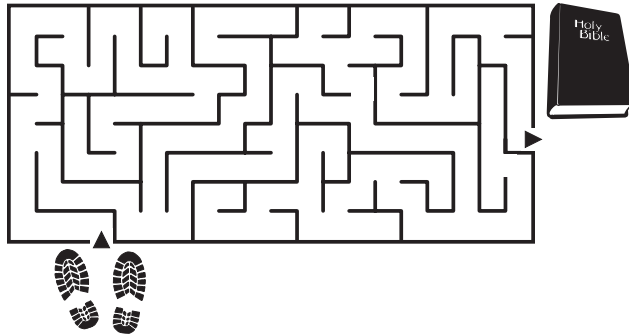
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Matthew 6:13

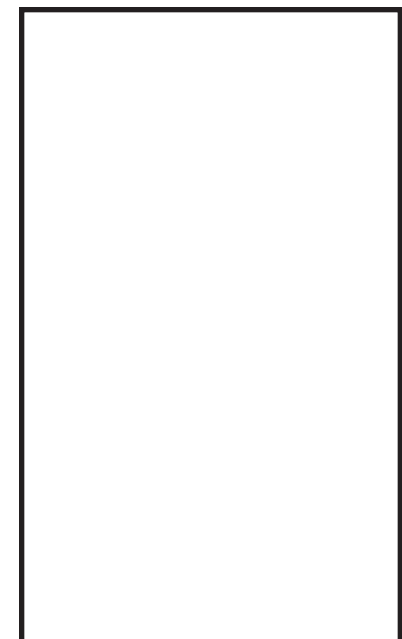
You've learned all of The Lord's Prayer! See if you can say all of it without looking. If you need help, hold this paper up to the mirror to see all of the verses.

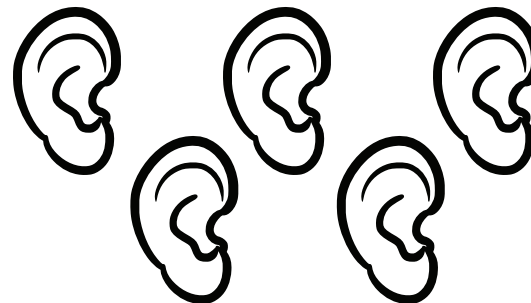
Matthew 6:13

—Jeremiah 10:10

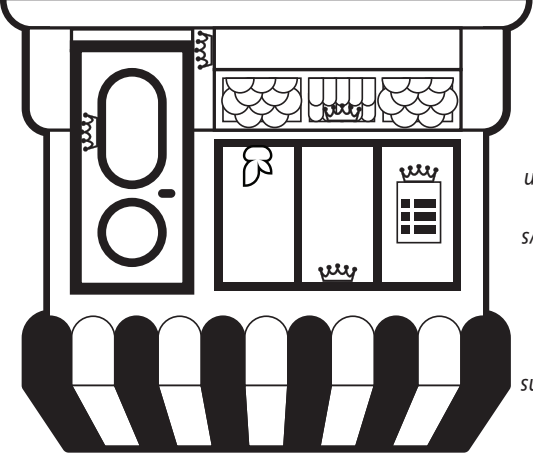
3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Have you been listening to Jesus, the king? Why or why not? Talk to Him about it.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Jesus is the King of everything! He has always been and always will be. He is the one who made the universe, and He is the one who has the right to say how it should work. Because He made you and loves you, He knows what is best for you. You can trust His way is best even when you would rather follow your own way.

—James 1:14

3 PRAY ABOUT IT!

Thank God for the things you wrote down. Ask God to help you grow to love Him more and to help you want to live His way.

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

One reason it can be hard to live God's way is because you often want to do things your own way instead. You might think that what you want will make you happier than what God wants. Or you might think that God's way is just too hard or not fair. When you are tempted to do something that is wrong, remember God is good and His way is best. The more you grow in your love for God, the more you will want what He wants.

There are many ways to grow in your love for God. One way is by thanking Him for all He has done for you. Make a list of things you are thankful for on another piece of paper. You can even use some of them to write a poem or song to God.

1 READ ABOUT IT!

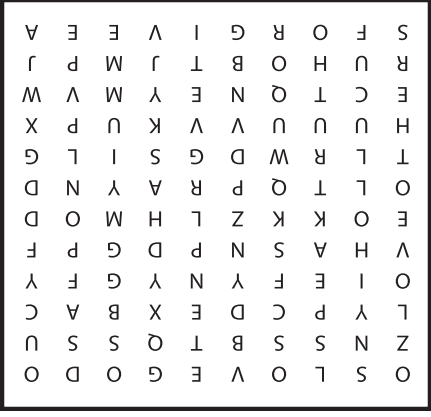
"But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."

2 THINK ABOUT IT!

Part of listening to Jesus is to obey what He says. If you believe in Jesus, you should live like it by living His way. You learn how Jesus wants you to live in God's true Word, the Bible. It isn't always easy to live God's way, but you don't have to do it on your own. When you believe in Jesus, God the Holy Spirit comes to live in you to help you live God's way.
