

DISPENSATIONAL PREMILLENNIALISM


- 1. Use a Literal, Historic, Grammatical method of Interpretation

- 3. The Church is <u>Distinct From Israel</u>— Started at Pentecost & consists of all <u>True Believers</u> in Christ—It is God's <u>Present Program</u> What about Israel?
- 4. Christ's Kingdom has a <u>Spiritual Aspect</u>, but there is also a <u>Literal</u> <u>Physical Kingdom</u> that will take place on <u>Planet Earth</u> The duration of the Kingdom will be <u>1000 years & forever</u>

Christ will rule on David's Throne & Israel will have it Kingdom

HISTORIC PREMILLENNIALISM

1. Other names for this view <u>Classic Premillennialism; Covenant Premillennialism;</u>

Non-Dispensational Premillennialism

- 2. God's Promises to Abraham were Conditional, the church Replaces Israel
- 3. There will be a Literal Kingdom of Christ on earth— There is a future for National Israel
- 4. The Church will go through the <u>Tribulation</u>—It will be used to <u>Purify the Church</u> & Root out <u>False Members</u>
- 5. Christ's Coming is not <u>Imminent</u>—There are certain events that must take place before Christ returns
- 6. The Rapture and the Second Coming take place <u>At the Same Time</u>—there is only <u>One</u> <u>Coming not Two</u>
- 7. Christ will Come Back at the end of the Tribulation and begin His Millennial reign
